Luke has been employed within the Australian Army for seven years working as an Aircraft Technician on the Black Hawk helicopter. During this time he has promoted to the rank of Corporal which recognises a superior level of intellect, maturity and professionalism.

At this Supervisor position, Luke has been responsible for daily leadership, management and tasking of small teams comprising approximately 10 people. This position is an extremely critical part within the Army team structure, having the most influence and direct interaction with junior soldiers meaning Luke's teamwork and leadership abilities were constantly utilised. Other responsibilities include maintaining technical trade skills, managing the organisation's aircraft maintenance data system via stringent quality control metrics, mentoring and training junior soldiers, managing and resolving soldier's welfare while supervising and being legally responsible in a highly technical and complex aviation maintenance environment.

Luke provided a high level of combat fitness instruction to the regiment. He developed, assessed and maintained individual's physical capacities to allow them to perform routine and mission specific duties effectively. His verbal presentation abilities are excellent and he commonly displays this through conducting physical training sessions for large groups exceeding thirty people while also possessing a presentation style appropriate when briefing superiors in smaller formal settings. His written communication skills are also very well developed through frequent technical report writing in his current role.
